## Building/Grounds/Maintenance

### Station Maintenance:

## **Apparatus**

### Apparatus Out of Service:

- 1261 was out of service for two days due to some issues with the brakes/brake pedal, it also received new front steer tires due to one of the fronts showing very poor wear.
- Heavy Apparatus will be getting their preventive maintenance done towards the end of September or early October.

## **Significant Calls of Interest**

- 08/14/18 - #18-0426 – Structure Fire - 1276 and 1210 were requested on a MABAS alarm to respond to the City of Waukesha for a commercial structure fire. 1276 assisted with overhaul and ventilation of the building, 1210 assisted the staging officer.
- 08/19/18 - #18-0442 – Structure Fire – Vernon was dispatched for a residential structure fire. 1202 arrived and requested the working still on card 12-22. 1263 arrived on scene and began fire suppression. Vernon crews along with the mutual aid departments were able to contain the fire to the room of origin.
- 08/20/18 - #18-0442 – Vehicle Fire – Vernon was dispatched to I-43 for a fully involved vehicle fire. 1263 arrived on scene and was able to extinguish and overhaul the vehicle.
