- 1261 has been having an occasional issue with the check engine light coming on and it is being evaluated by the apparatus service company.

## **Significant Calls of Interest**

- 6/27/2019 - #19-0325 – Structure Fire – New Berlin – Vernon was requested automatic aid to New Berlin for a report of a structure fire in a residential building. 1263 responded and upon arrival was assigned to overhaul after the fire was under control.
- 6/27/2019 - #19-0328 – Smoke Investigation – Mukwonago – Vernon was requested mutual aid to the Wal-Mart in Mukwonago for a deli case that was smoking. 1203 and 1261 responded. Crews made contact with Mukwonago chief inside the building, who advised he has been unable to locate the problem and the deli case was no longer smoking. 1261 was then cleared by command.
- 6/29/2019 - #19-0335 – Structure Fire – Hartland – Vernon was requested via MABAS on the first alarm for one chief to respond for a change of quarters. 1204 responded to Harland Fire Station #1. 1204 was then requested to the scene and was assigned safety and assisted with command operation. Command then upgraded to a second alarm and Vernon was requested for one ambulance direct to the scene. 1251 responded and was cleared shortly after arriving on scene. 1204 remained on scene and assisted for a majority of the remaining incident.
- 6/30/2019 - #19-0336 – Fire Alarm – Town of Waukesha- Vernon was requested automatic aid to the Town of Waukesha for a fire alarm. 1221 was first arriving unit with nothing showing from the exterior of the building. 1221 performed an investigation with Town of Waukesha Truck Company and located smoke in the fire pump room which was ventilated. 1263 was cleared from the scene to handle other storm related calls in Vernon. 1221 provided Town of Waukesha Chief with all details of incident and then cleared and returned.
