Significant Calls of Interest

- 9/13/2019 - #19-0509 – Structure Fire – City of Waukesha – Vernon was requested on a first alarm through MABAS for one squad and a chief to respond to the scene of a structure fire in a large apartment complex in the City of Waukesha. 1201 and 1276 responded. Upon arrival 1201 was assigned to relieve the operations chief on division three and manage all crews working on the third floor of the building. 1276 was assigned to replace another crew on division three and continue with the assigned tasks of fire suppression, overhaul and search of occupants. 1276 performed this task for a few rotations until cleared by command. 1201 remained the division three operations chief until relieved and cleared to return by command.
- 9/21/2019 - #19-0530 – Structure Fire – New Berlin – Vernon was requested on the working still for an engine and a chief to respond to a structure fire in a condo complex. 1210 and 1261 responded. Upon arrival crew were advised to stage on scene and then were later cleared by command once fire was under control.
- 9/22/2019 - #19-0532 – Commercial Fire Alarm – Town of Waukesha – Vernon was requested automatic aid for one engine respond to a Girl Scout camp for an activated smoke alarm. 1263 responded and arrived on scene, during investigation it was found the smoke alarm was activated due to burnt bacon. 1263 along with the Town of Waukesha crew performed ventilation and then cleared the scene.
- 9/23/2019 – #19-0535 – Structure fire – Vernon – Vernon along with automatic mutual aid was toned out for a structure fire. Additional information to crews advised it was possible and appliance fire that was extinguished. 1223, 1263 and Mukwonago engine continued for investigation. Units arrived on scene of a residence with nothing showing from the exterior. Crews performed an investigation and determined there was no active fire, but the motor on the washing machine possibly burned up. Crews removed the washing machine from the residence and informed the owners. All crews then cleared the scene and returned to quarters.
