Apparatus Out of Service:

- Ambulance inspections were performed by state. 1252, 1253 passed with no issues. 1251 needs a light repaired that is scheduled.

Significant Calls of Interest

- 4/14/2019 - #19-0196 – Vernon – Motor Vehicle Collision with Entrapment – 1251, 1276 and 1201 were dispatched for a single vehicle collision, originally described as possibly property damage only and collision with minor injuries. While units were enroute dispatch provided addition information the received stated it was now classified as a high mechanism collision with entrapment. 1201 arrived and began size up and planning. 1251 initiated patient care and 1276 rapidly extricated the patient from the vehicle. 1251 transported the patient to a trauma center.
- 4/23/2019 - #19-204 – Waterford – Structure Fire – 1276 was requested by Waterford to respond to a structure fire. 1276 arrived and was assigned to relieve the initial fire suppression crew and begin overhaul. 1276 was then assigned to go to rehab where one member was treated on scene for fatigue. 1276 was then cleared by command.
