Significant Calls of Interest

- 4/10/2020 - #20-171 – Structure Fire – Waterford – Vernon was requested to respond mutual aid with a squad and chief to a structure fire in Waterford. 1276, 1202, and 1204 responded. 1276 was assigned to search and rescue as well as overhaul. 1202 and 1204 were assigned to various tasks within the command system and assisted with fire investigation.
- 4/18/2020 – #20-0186 – Outside Fire – Mukwonago – Vernon was requested via the MABAS system on the box alarm to respond to a large outside fire with an engine and chief in Mukwonago. 1263 and 1202 responded. 1263 crew assisted in the field with fire suppression, and 1202 was assigned to the field operations chief.
- 4/28/2020 - #20-203 – Motor Vehicle Collision – Town of Waukesha – Vernon was requested automatic aid to the Town of Waukesha for a paramedic intercept for a high mechanism motor vehicle collision with entrapment. 1288, 1202 responded. Units arrived on scene with Town of Waukesha and began patient assessment, 1253 was requested to respond due to number of patients. It was determined there was one fatality involved in the collision. 1253 arrived on scene and was quickly diverted to a second call for service the Town of Waukesha received. 1288 and 1202 remained on scene to assist with the investigation.
- 4/29/2020 - #20-205 – Structure Fire – Tichigan – Vernon was requested via the MABAS system on the box alarm for an engine and chief respond to a structure fire. 1261, 1210 1202 responded. 1261 was assigned to ventilation and overhaul. 1210 and 1202 were assigned various tasks in the incident command system.
