Significant Calls of Interest

- 6/8/2020 - #20-0271 – Structure Fire – Mukwonago – A commercial structure fire was discovered by 1203. 1203 contacted Mukwonago dispatch and advised of a working structure fire. Other Vernon units were then requested via the MABAS box, 1261 and 1202 responded. 1203 was assigned operations, 1202 was assigned safety, 1261 assisted with fire suppression and overhaul.
- 6/16/2020 - #20-0285 – Structure Fire – Mukwonago - Vernon was requested via MABAS for an engine and chief to respond to a residential structure fire. 1263 and 1210 responded. 1210 assisted with the incident command system and 1263 assisted with overhaul.
- 6/16/2020 - #20-0288 – Structure Fire – Tess Corners – Vernon was requested via MABAS for an engine and chief to respond to a residential structure fire. 1263 and 1210 responded. 1210 assisted with the incident command system and 1263 assisted with fire suppression.
- 6/25/2020 - #20-0312 – Structure Fire – Town of Waukesha – Vernon was requested automatic aid for an engine and chief to respond to a residential structure fire. 1202, 1204, 1210 and 1261 responded. 1210 was the first unit to arrive on scene and establish command. 1261 arrived on scene and initiated fire suppression of a small fire started on a cedar shingle roof from a burn pit ember. 1202 and 1204 assisted in the incident command system. 1261 then assisted Town of Waukesha units with overhaul.
