Significant Calls of Interest

- 5/3/2020 - #20-0213 – Structure Fire – Mukwonago – Vernon was requested to respond mutual aid with an engine and chief direct to scene of a structure fire in Mukwonago. 1261, 1203 responded. MFD had the fire under control upon Vernon unit's arrival. 1261 assisted with overhaul, while 1203 assisted with in the command structure.
- 5/7/2020 - #20-0216 – Structure Fire – East Troy – Vernon was requested through the MABAS system to respond to a structure fire in an apartment building. 1202, 1261, and 1253 all responded during the incident. 1202 assisted in the command system, 1261 was assigned to RIT operations, and 1253 treated one patient on scene.
- 5/7/2020 - #20-0217 – Motor Vehicle Collision – Vernon – Vernon was dispatched to a motor vehicle collision with in the district. 1201, 1202, 1253, and 1276 responded. Upon arrival of the first unit it was determined to be a car versus motorcycle. It was determined there was one fatality involved in the collision.
- 5/19/2020 - #20-237 – Commercial Structure Fire – New Berlin – Vernon was requested for one chief and engine report for a change of quarters. A special request was then made by New Berlin for the Vernon Chief and Vernon squad report to the scene. 1201, 1276 responded to the scene and 1261 responded to the change of quarters. As the incident progressed 1261 was later requested to the scene. 1201 assisted with in the command structure, 1276 assisted with rehab and filling air bottles with the on-board cascade system. 1261 initially stood by at Nbfd St.1 for any other calls in their district and then once moved to the scene assisted with fire suppression and overhaul.
