You are receiving this correspondence by virtue of the nature of the business you engage in or the service you provide. Your organization or business has been identified as a **“Vulnerable Organizational Entity”**, outlined in Section 168-1(6)(a)(b)(c) of the New York State Correction Law, “Sex Offender Registration Act”. Most offenders in NY State are not restricted as to where they can reside, so being informed about who is living in close proximity to your location is very important!

The purpose of this letter is to notify your business or organization of the fact that certain information concerning “convicted sex offenders” residing in your area is available to you in either electronic format or by contacting your local law enforcement agency.

The Cayuga County Sheriff's Office will be sending you an email with offender information for offenders who move into proximity to your address or district. In addition, you may go to our community web page and find the Sex Offenders link and access our OffenderWatch page and search for offenders by address or name. You may register your home address(es) or family members and there is no limit to the number of offenders you can track or addresses you can register.

You can access information for all Level 1, 2, and 3 convicted Sex Offenders residing in Cayuga County by visiting **“Offender Watch”** on the Cayuga County Sheriff's Office website.

**To Access Sex Offender Information on “Offender Watch”**

Click on the **“Sex Offenders”** box on the main page and you will be taken directly to the **“Offender Watch”** page. You may search for convicted sex offenders living in proximity to your entity by Name, or radius. You may also sign up to receive email alerts anytime a convicted sex offender moves into your area. You may also access the tip link and send our office tips, updates, or corrections on any offenders.

**What If I Don't Have Access to the Internet?**


- Local libraries provide limited internet access at no charge.
