Dear Village Resident,

The McIntosh Aid Fund was established in 1914. The original charter states that “The fund is for the aid of people who are seriously sick or injured by accident and who are financially unable to cope with it; and not for light cases of sickness or accident.”

The purpose of the Fund is to first and foremost benefit the citizens of the Village of Cayuga by providing benefits for the payment of doctors, surgeons, nurses, prescriptions, and hospitals. The McIntosh Aid Fund Board of Directors recognizes that there are circumstances where additional assistance is needed, and Fund benefits may also be available for those special circumstances.

In order to request benefits, a completed application form and appropriate supporting documentation must be submitted to the address above by October 1, 2023.

It is important to remember that submitting an application does not necessarily guarantee that you will receive assistance from the Fund. Decisions regarding funding (full or partial) will be made by the Board of Directors at a date to be determined due to COVID-19 following the year for which assistance is sought.

This opportunity is available due to the generosity of the McIntosh Family, which has been a strong supporter of this Village for many years. In addition to the McIntosh Aid Fund, the Village solicits and receives yearly stipends under the auspices of the Cayuga Foundation to provide a swim program at Harris Park along with upkeep and maintenance for Harris Park and the McIntosh Fields which are used for Youth Sports and Community events. It is a blessing and a privilege to be a part of this family’s legacy.
