

Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Rouses Point, New York held on Thursday, March 19, 2015 at the Village Office Complex located at 139 Lake Street beginning at 4:00 p.m.

Mayor Rivers called the meeting to order and explained the purpose of the meeting was to accept the Statement of Canvass of Votes cast at the Village Election held on March 18, 201. The following was reported:

There were 167 residents that voted by hand ballots and 6 absentee ballots for a total of 173 ballots.

**For the position of Trustees there were two (2) candidates for the two (2) – two (2) year terms.**

Arvil J. Moore received 113 votes by hand ballots at the polls and 5 absentee ballots for a total of 118 votes

Joseph R. Treadwell received 60 votes by hand ballots at the polls and 5 absentee ballots for a total of 65 votes

**There were 5 Write-In Votes:**

John Mott received 98 write in votes

Ben Arno received 17 write in votes

Tom Marlow received 1 write in vote

Tim Mott received 1 write in vote

Dennis Roberts received 1 write in vote

Trustee Moore made a motion to accept the Canvass of Election; Seconded by Trustee Treadwell; AYE CARRIED

The Clerk announced that she received from the Treasurer today the 2015-2016 Tentative Budget and presented it to the Board.

The Clerk asked the Board to address the training for the Planning & Zoning Boards. She stated that some members wish to attend the training in Lake Placid but would like to spend the night. There is \$1400 in the budget for both Boards. Trustee Moore made a motion to allow the members to spend the night; use the Village Vehicle; and car pool if necessary; to stay within the budget. Pending the members wishing to go will determine if they stay the night or not; Seconded by Trustee Treadwell; AYE CARRIED
