

Membership Rules for the Dodge Memorial Library Rouses Point, NY

1. Anyone who lives in the Clinton, Essex or Franklin counties and can show proof of current residency with a picture ID is allowed to get a library card. If they live in a community in one of these counties with an automated public library, they should be encouraged to get a card at that library. If they already have a card from an automated library in the CEF Library System, that card will be honored at the Rouses Point Dodge Memorial Library.
2. If you have a permanent address in Clinton, Essex or Franklin counties, there will be no fee to get a library card. If you have a permanent address outside of the three county areas, there will be a fee of \$10.00 to get a library card. Permanent address means your residence that you live in seven months or more of the year.
3. Fines on overdue items are \$.05 per day. We expect all fines to be paid in full before more items can be checked out. There are book drops at the front door of the library and in the library parking lot which holds books of all sizes. Please use these drops to return items at your convenience so they are returned on time.
4. If you are new to our library, please keep the number of items borrowed to two (2) per person for the first month that you use the library.
5. Lost, destroyed or damaged items must be paid for in full before borrowing more items.
6. Any resident of Alburgh, Vermont or are a seasonal resident; you will be eligible to apply for a library card with no cost at the Dodge Memorial Library, Rouses Point, NY.
7. If your patron account incurs fines of \$50 or more, you will be considered a delinquent borrower and your account will be blocked from borrowing items from the Rouses Point Dodge Memorial Library or any other library in the Library System.
