

VILLAGE OF THREE OAKS PUBLIC HEARING MEETING – DATE: 10-11-17

Village President, David Grosse called the Public Hearing Meeting to consider Proposed Rate changes for the Sewer R-T-S Fees and a new rate for Water Usage over 100,000 gallons to order at 7:04 pm at the Three Oaks Village Hall after the Regular Council Meeting was closed.

Public Comment on the Agenda: Nancy Reitz of 206 Paw Paw Street asked for clarification on the reason / need for raising the Sewer R-T-S fees.

- **PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AN INCREASE in the SEWER R-T-S FEE and to SET A NEW RATE for WATER USAGE OVER 100,000 GALLONS:** It was explained that the Sewer R-T-S fees have not been increased since 2009 and that at the current rate they do not cover the principal payment of the Sewer Bond. It is proposed that the Sewer R-T-S rate be increased to \$21.00/month. It was also recommended that a new tier of water rates be established for high usage customers that use over 100,000 gallons per month. This rate would drop by \$.50 to \$4.68/1,000 gallons. The Water R-T-S rate and the usage rate for customers using under 100,000 gallons would remain the same.
- **Public Hearing was adjourned at 7:07 pm.**
