ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILPERSON

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DAVID KWIATKOWSKI AS CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE VILLAGE OF WALTON HILLS, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, since August 1, 2017 Stan Jaworski has served as Police Chief of the Village of Walton Hills, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 737.15; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jaworski has served with distinction and has decided to retire effective June 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed David Kwiatkowski, and this Council desires to confirm the appointment of David Kwiatkowski as Chief of Police for the Village of Walton Hills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WALTON HILLS, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor has appointed David Kwiatkowski as Chief of Police for the Village of Walton Hills, Ohio pursuant to the terms set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 737.15 and Walton Hills Codified Ordinance 260.18. This Council hereby confirms the Mayor’s appointment, effective June 8, 2023, subject to any requirements of OPATA and/or the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

SECTION 2. The compensation for the Chief of Police shall be as directed in Codified Ordinance 260.18.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the Police Chief is required to continue the day to day operations of the Village; wherefore this Resolution shall take effect and be in force upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all the members elected to Council, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
