

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY**  
**November 14, 2012**

Prior to the weekly selectmen's meeting, at 6:00 pm the selectmen met with Mike Marriner of Marriner Paving, to discuss town road upgrades. No decisions were reached.

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the November 7, 2012, selectmen's meetings was unavailable.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$3,937.35 and an accounts payable warrant of \$11,917.80. As of November 14<sup>th</sup> online banking records at Machias Saving Bank showed \$100,997.22 in the operating account and \$805,329.46 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities November 4 - 10. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept the report. One plow truck has been repaired at Cushing Diesel and the other is still there.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report. Bob presented the selectmen with an updated spreadsheet of the status of gravel pit and rock mine inspections.

The selectmen voted unanimously to adopt a resolution which approved the Knox County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:22 pm.
