

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
March 14, 2012

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the March 7, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$2,923.31 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$7,535.44.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present and provided a report of his CEO and LPI activities since January 1st.

The selectmen posted the bid notices for cemetery maintenance and maintenance of town grounds for the 2012 spring/summer season.

The selectmen renewed the application that allows town officials to view and purchase materials and equipment at the State of Maine Surplus Warehouse.

The selectmen voted unanimously to renew the policy that requires that property taxes paid to the tax collector be applied to the oldest overdue taxes first.

All three selectmen will attend the Knox County Budget Committee Public Hearing on Thursday, March 15th at the Knox County Courthouse.

The selectmen voted unanimously to have a title search done on the "Achorn Lot" that the town foreclosed on several years ago for unpaid taxes. It is hoped that a title search will allow the lot to be sold. Don will contact attorney Fred Newcomb to inquire if he would conduct the title search.

Don will meet with Tom Stevens on Friday morning to review any headstone work needed to be accomplished in 2012.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:24 pm
