

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
March 28, 2012

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the March 21, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$7,919.45 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$104,841.84.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report of his activities.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report.

Don reported that an email had been received that decreased the Union Ambulance assessment for 2012 to \$9,937.10 from \$10,900 planned in the 2012 budget. An amendment to the warrant to show the decreased amount will be made at town meeting.

The selectmen reviewed the articles for town meeting to anticipate citizen questions.

Wesley reported that the audit of the Workers Compensation resulted in a \$600 reduction in the 2012 cost.

The selectmen and town treasurer discussed a supplemental bill from Maine Municipal Association for a worker's compensation premium. After a lengthy discussion with numerous unknowns and lots of confusion, Don volunteered to schedule an appointment at MMA to resolve the issue. He will be in Augusta on April 5th for work and will try to schedule an appointment for that day.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:35 pm
