

SELECTMAN'S MEETING SUMMARY

JUNE 13, 2012

Prior to the weekly selectman's meeting a public hearing took place in the Bryant room concerning recent changes to the General Assistance Program. The new changes initiated by the state were adopted and the public hearing was closed

The weekly selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Wes Daniel with selectman Duane Vigue present and selectman Don Grinnell absent.

The summary of the June selectman's meeting was read and approved as written.

Frank Jones Jr., the Road Commissioner was absent but provided a report of the prior week.

Bob Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was absent and provided no report.

The selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3330.94 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$14,662.22

Bob Temple Code Enforcement Officer will be doing a follow up this week of several letters that were sent to citizens about debris and clutter in their yards.

The road side mowing bids are due to be read at the next selectman's meeting on June 20, 2012.

The selectman voted unanimously to accept a salt bid from Harcross Chemical. They were the lowest bidder at \$57.67 a ton delivered. They are also a Maine company.

Tax Assessor has asked for the appropriations from the town meeting so that he can ready the 2012 tax commitment.

A public notice was given by the state concerning the recent changes to the General Assistance Program. A committee will go over the new changes and make recommendations related to the changes.

The Selectman received a report from the Knox County Emergency Management Assoc. reviewing the training seminar that was recently held by director Don Grinnell.
