

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
July 3, 2012

With Independence Day following on Wednesday, an abbreviated weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the June 27, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$3,265.84 and an accounts payable warrant in the amount of \$8,849.80.

The selectmen have scheduled a budget committee meeting for 6:00 – 7:00 pm, on Wednesday, July 18th for a mid-year review of municipal finances.

The selectmen will complete annual performance appraisals after the selectmen's meeting on July 18th.

Duane was contacted by Michelle Robinson who asked if a "Children at Play" sign could be placed on the Old Union Road it approaches the Village area. The selectmen voted to direct Frank to put the sign up. This led to a discussion about possibly requesting the MDOT for authorization to change the speed limit on Old Union Road and Bill Luce Road west of Bartlett's Garage to the Village to 25 mph. They will have further discussion at an upcoming meeting.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:20 pm.
