

## SELECTMAN'S MEETING SUMMARY

OCT. 16<sup>TH</sup> 2013

The weekly Selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectman Duane Vigue present and Selectman Donald Grinnell absent.

The summary of the October 9<sup>th</sup> selectman's meeting was approved as written.

The Selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$2,503.56 and an additional payroll warrant in the amount of \$2559.02. The Selectman also voted unanimously to approve two accounts payable warrants one in the amount of \$163,695.91 for paving of town roads and \$111,470.29 which included payment to the MSAD 40 school district.

Roads Foreman John Daniel was absent and provided no written report.

Judson Butterman was appointed as Election Warden for the Town.

Duane will contact Health Connections in Rockport to schedule respirator fitting tests for the entire Roads Crew which is a standard requirement.

At 7:27 p.m. Bob Temple, CEO, asked to enter into executive session under 1M.R.S.A. s/s 405 to discuss legal matters concerning the Linscott gravel pit located on the McDowell Road.

At 7:50 p.m. the Selectman moved to return to regular session.

The Linscott's have hired Attorney Cristin Collins to represent their interests concerning the gravel pit on the McDowell Road.

Wesley Daniel made a motion to have Bob Temple, the Town's CEO, contact the Town's Attorney Fred Newcomb to discuss options concerning a course of action pertaining to the gravel pit on the McDowell Rd. The motion was seconded and approved.

A motion was made and approved to issue a Stop Work Order to Nancy and Berkley Linscott pertaining to their gravel pit located on the McDowell Rd. The Stop Work Order will be issued due to requirements that were not met by a dead line of Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> 2013. Options for future actions or remedies will be determined and discussed at the Selectman's Meeting on Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

With no further business to come before the board the Weekly Selectman's meeting was adjourned at 7:58 p.m.
