

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
November 27, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Duane Vigue with Selectmen Donald Grinnell also present. Selectman Wesley Daniel was absent.

The summary of the November 20, 2013 selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$3,225.54 and an accounts payable warrant of \$5,073.72. After payment of this weeks warrants an online review of Machias Saving Bank indicated \$100,000 in the operating account and \$811,967.37 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities November 17-23. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report.

Bob Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent.

The selectmen received notification that the Knox County 2014 Budget Public Hearing and vote by the County Commissioners will be held at 6:00 pm, Thursday, December 5, in the Jury Assembly Room of the Knox County Court House. This proposed 2014 budget shows a decrease to Washington of approximately \$2,700. Interested citizens will attend.

The selectmen announced the receipt of the Local Roads Assistance Program (previously called the Urban/Rural Initiative Program) for 2013 in the amount of \$49,308.00.

The selectmen discussed proposed changes to the Town of Washington Personnel Policy regarding sick leave. Any decision was postponed until next week when Wesley returns.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and adjourned at 7:18 pm.
