

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
December 11, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the December 4, 2013 selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$4,236.41 and an accounts payable warrant of \$5,908.83. The selectmen reviewed the TRIO revenue, expense, and GL report dated December 11th. They noted that actual 2013 revenues in revenue sharing, tree growth reimbursement, interest on overdue taxes will fall short of anticipated revenues but will exceed estimates in excise taxes, mining permit fees, veterans tax exemption reimbursement.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was present but had no report.

Bob Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, briefed the selectmen on the following issues:

- 1) Bob has been in contact with town attorney Fred Newcomb who stated that the potential contempt of a court order by Andrew Thompson will have start again as a separate issue.
- 2) The selectmen reviewed photos of recent activity at the Linscott unpermitted pit on McDowell Road. Don will try to contact Mr. Newcomb to get a clarification on how to proceed with the violation of the letter sent to Mr. and Mrs. Linscott on May 25.

The selectmen met with Bill Lane, Engineer with Gartley and Dorsky, to review plans for the tow culvert replacement projects on Vanner Road and Youngs Hill Road. Mr. Lane will assist the town in preparing a rebuttal to the salmon restoration requirements by the Army Corps of Engineers.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve and then signed the warrant for the special town meeting scheduled for December 30th.

George Stone has contracted with Peter Luce to demolish the former Fred Ludwig Store and Post Office after it was deemed a public nuisance by the selectmen. Demolition is supposed to be completed by December 31st.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 8:20 pm.
