

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
May 29, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the May 22, 2013, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$7,072.64 and an accounts payable warrant of \$2,549.60. An online review of accounts at Machias Savings Bank showed \$99,593.72 in the operating account and \$224,341.18 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but had a written report of his activities May 19-25. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept Jonathan's report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was present but had no written report. Bob briefed the selectmen on the status of the following open issues:

- 1) Bob has met with Martha Morrison and the selectmen agreed to set July 31st as a final date to clear the premises of junk and bring it into compliance. The issue regarding the domestic animals on the property now rests with the State.
- 2) Bob's meeting with Larry Sukeforth was postponed due to Mr. Sukeforth's illness.

The selectmen acknowledged Cyd and Debbie Zeigler and then discussed the Zeigler's application for sale of wine for on-premises consumption at their bed and breakfast. Don had conducted some research and determined that the town had never had a referendum question for on-premises consumption. That can only be called as a local referendum by a local petition. Don will confirm with MMA and report back directly to the Zeigler's.

The selectmen voted unanimously to set apply the State share of the Blizzard "13 reimbursement funds (\$2,440.86) to the Road Reserve account.

Local quotes for excavator work were submitted by George Carlazon (\$85 per hr), Peter Luce (\$80 per hr) and Merton Moore (\$100 large & \$75 small per hr). The selectmen voted unanimously to hire Peter Luce for any excavation work this summer.

The selectmen discussed adding an amendment to the Driveway Entrance Ordinance during the on-premises consumption referendum question.

The process to change vendor's for the office copier is in progress.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:57 pm.
