

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
June 6, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the May 29, 2013, selectmen's meeting was approved with a correction that Don will complete before posting.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$3,684.56 and an accounts payable warrant of \$9,864.92. An online review of accounts at Machias Savings Bank showed \$100,000.00 in the operating account and \$250,080.82 in the interest bearing sweep account. The selectmen reviewed the TRIO expense report date June 6.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but had a written report of his activities May 26 – June 1. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept Jonathan's report. The spring grading of the gravel roads has been completed at a cost of \$3,440.00 which is less than in previous years.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent and had no written report.

The selectmen voted unanimously to enter into 5-year contract with U.S. Government Purchasing Alliance to lease a new color copiers/canner/fax for the town office at a cost of \$160.26 per month.

The selectmen voted unanimously to sell the old copier to Farrar-Ross Post of the VFW for a price of \$1.00.

Upon a request from the town attorney, the selectmen voted unanimously to assess Timothy Jackson a fine of \$500.00 plus \$728.44 legal and court costs for his violation of the land use ordinance. The fine and costs must now be approved by the judge in Knox County District Court.

Don explained the process that he worked with the office staff for Cyd and Debbie Zeigler to circulate petitions for their request for a referendum question for on-premises consumption of malt beverages and wine at the Blueberry Fields B&B.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:28 pm.
