

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
February 5, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the January 29, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$3,991.93 and an accounts payable warrant of \$23,743.22. After this week's warrants were paid, an online review of town accounts held by Machias Savings Bank indicated \$100,000 in the operating account and \$534,665.44 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Road Foreman Jonathan Daniel was absent but provided a written report of his activities January 26 – February 1. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report.

Don confirmed that Maine Senator Chris Johnson and Representative Deborah Sanderson had both agreed to attend a meeting to discuss the impact of the proposed reductions to the revenue sharing program. The meeting will be held Feb 24th, 7:00 pm, in the Bryant Room. The other towns from Rep. Sanderson's District 52 have also been invited.

Wes presented proposals from Armstrong Landscaping for a three-year contract for mowing of town grounds and snow removal at the municipal complex. They also had a three-year proposal from Kennedy Mowing for the annual summer roadside mowing. The selectmen voted to postpone action on the proposals until minor questions could be answered.

Don announced that Wesley Richardson, interim town manager in Waldoboro, has agreed to moderate the annual town meeting on March 22nd.

With nothing else to come before the Board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:35.
