

SELECTMAN'S SUMMARY

SEPT. 24, 2014

The weekly selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Selectman Wes Daniel.

Selectman Duane Vigue was present with Selectman Don Grinnell being absent.

The summary for Sept. 17th was approved as written.

The Selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$4,027.66 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$238,831.34 which included the payments for MSAD 40 School District and the Knox County assessment.

The check book balance was \$835,342.56.

Roads Foreman John Daniel was absent and no Road Foreman report was presented.

Bob Temple- CEO- was present and stated that DEP was going to GPS well heads in the area of the proposed Hatch Body shop on Route 220 to ascertain if the Well Head Protection Program was affected by this proposal. Bob also inspected several of the towns gravel pits.
