

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING
October 22, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the October 15, 2014, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$2,984.90 and an accounts payable warrant of \$120,738.85 which included the RSU 40 monthly assessment of \$107,960.53.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent and had no written report.

The selectmen signed a letter to the town attorney stating the selectmen's final negotiating position for the mediation meeting between the Town and Berkley and Nancy Linscott scheduled for October 30th.

The selectmen announced that they would convene a special selectmen's meeting at 12:30 pm on October 30th. After convening they will then travel to the mediation meeting at the law office of Paul Gibbons in Camden.

The selectmen voted unanimously to grant a property tax abatement in the amount of \$34.98 on Map 4 / Lot 24 due to an error in assessment.

At 7:09 the selectmen voted to enter into executive session under the provisions of 1M.R.S. § 405 (6) (F) to discuss a poverty abatement. They returned to regular session at 7:14 and voted unanimously to postpone action on the poverty abatement until a completed application is received.

The proposed 2016 Knox County Budget is available for review in the town office or online at the Knox County website. The Knox County Budget Committee is meeting weekly to act on the budget.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 7:17 pm.
