

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING
November 19, 2014

Due to a mutual aid fire call necessitating Wes and Don to respond, the weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:42 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the November 12, 2014, selectmen and assessors meetings was unavailable but will be available at next week's meeting.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$6,735.17 and an accounts payable warrant of \$124,560.11 that included the monthly RSU 40 school assessment and the annual firefighter stipends. It also included a payment of \$2,719.71 to Maritime Energy 1/3 payment for a new furnace at the town garage.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent due to the late convening of the meeting. The selectmen discussed the actions completed thus far in the Linscott consent agreement. They are still awaiting the final document to review.

The selectmen will be attending a meeting in Union with the other towns served by Union Ambulance to discuss hiring additional personnel on a per diem status. This meeting, at 6:30 pm on December 4th should provide cost figures to all four towns for the proposed additional personnel.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 8:23 pm.
