

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 12, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the March 2, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3,048.47 and an accounts payable warrant of \$8,574.37. After payment of this week's warrants an online review of municipal accounts held by Machias Savings Bank indicated there was \$100,000.00 in the operating account and \$430,472.40 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities March 2-8. The damaged overhead door at the town garage has been repaired and all other doors have been serviced.

Due to the snowstorm Robert Temple, Code Enforcement officer, was absent and had no report.

Also due to the snowstorm the scheduled meeting with the MMA Risk Pool representative for the insurance annual review has been postponed to March 25th at 9:00 am in the Bryant Room

The selectmen reviewed and signed an updated policy regarding 30-day check clearing for check received to clear liens and a 45-day policy for checks to clear to prevent foreclosure for unpaid taxes.

The town has received notification the FEMA has denied Governor Lapage's request for a Presidential Disaster Declaration for the December 2013 ice storm. There will be no reimbursement for ice storm expenses or cleanup.
