

## SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 30, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the April 23, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved with one correction.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3,893.63 and an accounts payable warrant of \$2,990.13.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities April 20-26. The selectmen voted unanimously to approve the report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement officer, was present and briefed the selectmen on the following:

- 1) He has started the 2014 mining inspections and has a new filing system for them.
- 2) Bob will be working with Bill Reinhart of George Hall and Sons about work to be done at the former Marriner gravel pits that George Hall & Sons now own south of Rte. 126.
- 3) Bob was recently at the town attorney's office to provide sworn affidavits in the Linscott and Steinmeyer land use violation cases.
- 4) The Hoffman's did not agree with the consent order from the town attorney that, as directed by the selectmen, required a fine and legal costs. The case will now proceed to a judge.

The chipper for the road maintenance crew has been ordered with a 2-3 week expected delivery.

With nothing additional to come before the Board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:42 pm.
