

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING
August 5, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the July 31, 2014, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3,732.26 and an accounts payable warrant of \$9,705.38. The selectmen reviewed TRIO GL, Revenue, and Expense reports dated August 5th.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report
