

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
September 21, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Public CEO – Bob Temple Public – Jane Carroll, Lynn Carroll, Kit Lascoutx

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 09/14/16 as presented, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Berkley Linscott moved to pay the warrants as presented \$3,252.46/payroll, \$10,788.78/vender, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 9/11 – 9/17 – 12th-13th shoulder work on Bump Hill and Hopkins Roads (finished Hopkins); 14th stock piled winter sand, worked on P500, power washed, fixed hydraulic hose and started brake job on P400. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob Temple reported he spoke with Mark Stebbins, DEP, regarding Sukeforth's pit. Mark said Sukeforth continues to have violations and will try to call him to contact us. Bob will check with the Registry of Deeds on who owns the pit. Tom Johnston asked about the Stop Work Order which should be enforced. Bob said it has been issued and mailed and Bob is attempting to hand deliver it. Wesley Daniel asked Bob what time of day he has been attempting to find someone at the pit. Bob said he usually goes mid-morning. Tom Johnston will stop at Sukeforth's pit tomorrow morning to request that he speak with the Selectmen and Bob Temple A.S.A.P.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – None

Wesley Daniel stated he has scheduled a meeting with Peter Drum on September 28, 2016, during a Selectmen's Meeting.

There were unauthorized speed bumps on Skidmore Road. The Sheriff called the town office, Wesley Daniel went to speak with the homeowner who took care of the situation. There are no more speed bumps on Skidmore Road.

The Selectmen will meet at the town office on Tuesday, September 27 at 9am to do the auto graveyard inspections. Mary Anderson will email Bob Temple regarding the date/time.

Wesley Daniel gave the Selectmen a draft of the bid notice packets for road side mowing, mowing of town grounds, and cemetery maintenance. Wesley will send them out next week and request them back by the end of October.

There has been a problem of people not cleaning up after their dogs across the street near the fire pond and the soccer field. The Selectmen picked out a sign to be purchased and posted.

Questions and Comments

Kit Laxcoutx asked how long it will take for the Youngs Hill Culvert to be replaced. Tom Johnston said plan on three weeks.

Berkley Linscott asked to discuss and vote to have the paving on each side of Youngs Hill Road culvert done. Wesley Daniel moved to have the hot top done 50 feet of each side of the culvert and as far up as Frank Jones' driveway using funds from the Road Reserve account as part of the project, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

There was some discussion regarding the chipped seal and paving. Tom Johnston suggested the Road Committee continue working on checking the roads for paving. Wesley Daniel said the town paves at least 2 miles a year. Berkley Linscott stated that the town was able to pave two more roads this year.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 7:20PM.
