

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
January 6, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Duane Vigue, and Berkley Linscott; CEO – Bob Temple; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public: None

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the summary as written from 12/30/15, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the warrants as written \$5,034.82/payroll and \$20,237.22/vendor, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel reported on Public Works Report – 12/27 – 1/2/16 Worked on P300 putting plow and wing on, the rest of the week plowing and sanding. Duane Vigue moved to accept the report as read, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob reported that he completed the summary for the year. He had one more permit for swapping a trailer. He also received an application for the Linscott pit that will be presented to the Planning Board next Tuesday. Bob received two calls about Jackson's Auto Graveyard regarding debris outside the junkyard. He explained to both callers that they are in the process of cleaning it up. Steinmeyer is also making progress in his clean up.

Ann Dean reported that she closed the books out and sent the needed reports to the auditors to start preliminary work. When the December statement is complete the auditors will be contacted. Ann called two social service agencies (Penquis & Red Cross) to remind them to send in their petitions.

Wesley Daniel requested the signatures on two quitclaim deeds, Huntley (auto foreclosure) and Lassell who has sold property (and found that '81, '82, & '83 hadn't been released). Mary Anderson witnessed the Selectmen's signatures.

The Public Hearing for the Solar Ordinance is scheduled for Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 7PM. Wesley Daniel asked Mary Anderson to take notes at the meeting. After some discussion, Duane moved to present two separate articles (solar & wind/antenna) instead of a combined article (solar/wind/antenna) at the public hearing for the Solar Ordinance, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Questions and Comments

Berkley Linscott asked about air conditioning for the town office. After some discussion it was decided to get a quote and have a separate article at the town meeting.

Wesley Daniel will be out Monday and Tuesday of next week and asked if someone would show up at the town office Tuesday to help out.
