

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary  
May 31, 2017

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; CEO – Bob Temple;

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 05/24/17 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$3,039.52/payroll, \$125,433.82 (includes May school payment \$122,765.75)/vendor Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 05/21 – 05/27: 22<sup>nd</sup> - spread surface gravel on Firs Road and mixed gravel in the pit; 23<sup>rd</sup> - spread surface gravel on Mountain Road and Lenfest Road and mixed gravel in the pit, Anderson Equipment – trouble with loader; 24<sup>th</sup> - put up 911 signs, unplugged culverts on Old County Road and Mountain Road, time cards attached.

CEO Report – Bob Temple stated he issued three permits this past week. Bob asked David Bixby, building a house on Mountain Road, to clean up in front of his house which he agreed to do. Bob is working on another Shoreland Zoning permit. Wesley Daniel asked Bob what the status is on the Sukeforth agreement. Bob said he will look into the dates that Sukeforth agreed to for cleanup and follow-up. Tom Johnston asked if Bob had heard from DEP regarding Nelson Ridge Road. Bob heard that they found what amounted to a pint of oil and it has been cleaned up. Bob is waiting to received something, in writing, from DEP. Bob will follow-up if he doesn't hear soon.

Tom Johnston asked about the road applications. A couple have gone out but have not been returned.
