May 9, 2018

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 05/02/18, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$4,099.19/payroll; \$13,130.51 /vendor (with correction), Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.
