Road Foreman Weekly Report, July 30-August 3, 2018:

Monday: Check Road, talked to Lane. Went over all of the equipment. All three road crew

Tuesday: Fixed wash out on Bowman mills Road. 28 yard minus gravel. Two trucks and backhoe were used. All three road crew

Wednesday: Put in the propane line for the shop. Marked Fitch Road for DIG SAFE. Took trash to the transfer station. All three road crew

Fix the water tank.

Fix the emergency shut off switch button for the furnace.

Phil Meunier, Fire Chief, would like to have approval to add a propane tank prop for training at the town pit. He would like to do this before the fall season. The Board approved this request.

Wes confirmed that the LRAP (Local Roads Assistance Program) money cannot be used to buy equipment. I.e. York Rakes.

The Maine State Housing Authority has a program to replace mobile homes 1976 and older. The application will be posted at the town office and linked to the town web-site.

Tom stated that the landline and cell phone quotes for the town garage exceed the budget. This can possibly be revisited for next year's budget.

The recreation committee would like to put a fence up across the end of the practice field. Wes stated he will get some quotes.
