Public Works Report:

8/16 – Called out by Knox Sheriff's Department for two large trees on Old County Road. Chipped brush at intersection of Young's Hill Road & Crystal Lake Road. Chipped Brush on Mountain Road & Old County Road. Called Anderson Equipment about servicing the loader.

8/20 – Chipped brush on Albert Jones Road

8/21 – Patched culvert with cold patch on Fitch Road. Worked in shop; power washed the backhoe, power washed the floors in the shop. Jeff from JIMAR stopped by and a quote was done for snow plow cutting edges for winter.

8/22 – Put up a "Blind Drive Sign" on Calderwood Road. Picked up oil for the backhoe; put new oil and filter in backhoe. Took 20 tires to the transfer station.
