**CEO Report:**

Bill from CMP project called: they will be working off the Mountain Road / Youngs Hill Road after July 4<sup>th</sup> for about 3 weeks. There should be no issues pertaining to weight limits. Wesley did mention watching their speed.

Landscape project: Volunteers stepped-up and would like help with the clean-up. This would require buying mulch to be used in the flower beds.

Old Union Road project: needs to be marked for ditching for Dig Safe. Wes feels the road should be ditched or cleaned all the way to the end. Tom will mention this to Public Works.

Phil Meuner was present to discuss the issue with daytime coverage at the fire department. This is becoming a major issue in Washington and surrounding towns. Many well trained volunteers in Washington work during the day. A potential idea presented by Phil is to eventually acquire a pick-up truck (with a utility body) working through Union ambulance, employing someone five days a week. This person would be a first-responder for EMS and fire. Licensing would be done under Unions' license. There is also a possibility that we can bill the insurance companies for accidents. Residents would not get billed. Wes stated that a plan should be made, and go to town meeting with it.
