

Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

December 30, 2019

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of December 23, 2019: Motion to approve by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

12/23/19 6:30am-4:30pm: We worked on P-500 plow; Took sander out of P-100 to wash and grease; Pitch perfect tire came in to fix tires on the loader.

12/24/19 6:30am-12:30pm: Put in salt and made up sand; fixed the tailgate latch on P-200.

12/25/19 Christmas - Holiday

12/26/19 6:30am-2:30pm: We greased trucks and fueled them up; fixed plow on P-500; Made up sand.

12/27/19 6:00am-5:30pm: I called the guys in to sand for ice.

12/28/19 4:30am-9:00am: I called the guys in to sand for black ice.

Mary Anderson stated that there were two complaints regarding the plow drivers, plowing on bare pavement.

Wesley Daniel stated that after the roads have been salted, the roads are scraped to loosen up the ice. Tom Johnston also stated that it is easier on the trucks to run with the plows down instead of bouncing in the air.

CEO Report: Bob Temple was not in attendance.

Health Officer Report: Brian Alves was not in attendance.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson gave a card with a note for Dorothy and Henry Sainio, who are moving out of town, to the Selectmen for them to sign. Mary stated that we received a check from BETE for \$39,778.00; Lynn has been working to upload the printer drivers for the computers that have been upgraded to Windows 10; Mary asked the Selectmen if they would approve \$1 an hour more for Stan Millay, Assessor's Agent, as previously requested; Selectmen approved; Tom Johnston took out Nomination Papers for the Selectmen position and Guy Bourrie took out Nomination Papers for the School Board Committee; It was determined that according to the statutes, Richard Bissett can finish out Staci Bowman's term on the School Board Committee until 2021 without having to be elected; Berkley will post a correction.

Other Agenda Items:

-Planning Board Alternate: Sarah Collins sent a letter to the Selectmen expressing interest in joining the Planning Board as an alternate member. Wesley Daniel made a motion to appoint Sarah Collins to the Planning Board as an alternate member; Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

-Registrar of Voters: Wesley Daniel made a motion to approve the appointment of Joan Hayward as the Registrar of Voters and Mary Anderson as Deputy Registrar of Voters; Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

-Budget Workshop: Wesley Daniel suggested that the Selectmen along with Mary Anderson, Town Clerk/Treasurer and Frank Jones, Jr., Road Foreman, to meet to work on the 2020 budget in anticipation of the upcoming Budget Committee meeting on January 16, 2020. It was agreed upon to meet Tuesday morning, January 7 at 9:00am in the Bryant Room.
