Road Foreman Report:

3/25/19 6:30AM-4:30PM: We unplugged culvert on Vanner, Calderwood and Crystal Lake roads.

3/26/19 6:30AM-4:30PM: We worked on backhoe brakes and found a broken brake line, parts are on the way.

Replaced an alternator on P400; Patched the side of Bill Luce Road by Box 61.

3/27/19 6:30AM-4:30PM: Changed the oil in the chipper the oil cooler was broken; Put new blades in and greased it; Greased the loader; Put new brakes lines on backhoes still no brakes.

3/28/19 6:30AM-4:30PM: Hammond Tractor came and worked on the backhoe and got the brakes to work, I think; Put the backhoe back together; Patched the shoulder on Youngs Hill Road; Cleaned out ditch on Vanner Road by Rt 17.

Frank Jones, Jr stated that on 3/28/19 he went to Mountain Road with Wesley to speak to the land owner who is logging in the mud and to look at the condition of the road.

Wesley Daniel asked Berkley Linscott if he read the letter from DOT regarding driveways. Berkley answered in the affirmative.

Wesley Daniel stated that it's been estimated that the Town will need for 800 tons of salt for next year. Berkley Linscott was in agreement.

CMP will be meeting with the Selectmen in the Bryant Room on April 16, 2019 at 9:00AM.

Wesley Daniel stated that the Town received a proposal from Greg Boynton to screen winter sand. He will do it for the same price per yard as last year. He wants a two-year contract and he would get paid this year for this year and next year for next year. Wesley Daniel suggested that we increased the yardage from 3500 to 4000 per year. Berkley Linscott agreed that the price is acceptable. Berkley Made a Motion to accept the offer, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in Favor.

Frank Jones Jr. asked about quotes for renting an excavator, so the Road Crew could dig the ditches this summer vs hiring the job out. Union Farm Equipment is \$4,500.00, plus \$1,000.00 for a ditching bucket for 160 hours (4 weeks). Eagle Rental is \$3,000 for the machine, \$3,500 includes a trailer. Eagle Rental includes 2 ditching buckets. The Eagle Rental rate is their special rate for municipalities. To subcontract out the job would be \$100.00 an hour. Wesley Daniel and Berkley Linscott decided to table the decision until Tom Johnston returns.
