Road Foreman Report:

Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Tom Johnston: 12/23/2018: I checked roads for wash out and mud on Dorman, Old County, Lenfest roads. Had some wash out and mud all dirt roads; 12/24/2018: We patched washouts and mud spots and cleaned out culverts and ditches so water could run away from road. All the engine lights came on P100, broke spring in P300; 12/26/2018: We took P100 to O'Connors and we took spring out of P300, I went to get new springs and started putting back together; 12/27/2018: We finished putting P300 spring in so we can use it to plow. Will also replace rear brakes and caliper and fix lights; 12/28/2018: Called Kevin, Greg and Steven to plow and sand; 12/29/2018: We were called out to sand for ice on roadways the dirt roads took the most time. I called in Kevin, Greg and Jason.

CEO Report:

Bob Temple stated that he's still working on collecting mining permits. He is also working with the owner of the property that has a blocked fire lane. He is also still working on the amended subdivision, he is going to discuss it at the Planning Board meeting. He is also working is organizing files for 2019.
