Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of July 17, 2019: Motion to approve by Tom Johnston, 2nd by Berkley Linscott, All in favor.

Sign Treasurer's Warrant dated July 24, 2019:

A/P Vendor- \$266,795.95 (includes paving and RSU 40 payment)

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

7/15/19 6:00am-4:30pm: We worked on back hoe teeth; Called Chris Packard to help with ball field; Marked Skidmore Road for ditching and grading; started to patch culverts on Crystal Lake Road with 5 yards of cold patch.

7/16/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Finished patching culverts on Crystal Lake Road; Started ditching on Old County Road; Took out a driveway culvert that was not put in right and it was washing the road out when it rains, nor did they have a permit.

7/17/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Ditched on Old County Road.

7/18/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Changed oil in P-500 7954.4 hrs; Jacolby adjusted clutches in p-500 and P-400; I met with Dig Safe on Skidmore Road for ditching; Met with Jimar for cutting edges for fall; power washed P-400.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that the trailer on Calderwood is using a Porta-Potty, they are also disposing of their grey water properly. There have been 8 pits that have paid their fees and scheduled their inspections. The owner of the property on Rt 17 is working on getting his trailer moved to the rear of his property. He is still waiting for an inspection warrant for the property on Bill Luce Road.

Health Officer Report: Brian Alves stated that he is continuing to look into an unsafe living situation regarding a citizen.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that we received a revenue share check for \$8815.00. The bank balance is \$119,495.37.

Other Agenda Items:

Blinking Speed Limit Sign- Wesley Daniel presented 3 different proposals. The Selectmen chose the \$899 solar blinking speed limit sign. They also voted to purchase two lights because the budget allowed for 2. The 2nd light will be located after the school heading North on Rt 220. Joan Hayward volunteered to order the sign.

LRAP Certification- Wesley Daniel stated that the LRAP certification application has to be signed and submitted to receive the funds.

Consent Agreement for Keefe- Tom Johnston made a motion to sign the revised Keefe Agreement, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in Favor.
