5/28/19 6:30am-4:30pm: We replaced 1 culvert on Sprague Rd. 15x36; Started to ditch on Calderwood Rd.; Lane started on Old Union Rd.

5/29/19 6:30am-4:30pm: Kevin and Bill had Dr. appointment; Greg and I picked up P200; I went over Old Union Rd. with Lane and Hagar; Took 168 yards of gravel to Old Union Rd.

5/30/19 6:30am-4:30pm: We took surface gravel to Old Union Rd. for Lane; Started to make shoulder gravel for Old Union Rd.; I marked out intersection on Skidmore and Sprague Roads.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he is waiting to receive the inspection warrant for the property on Bill Luce Road. He is working on the property that had the complaint lodged against it on Crystal Lake Rd. He commented that there has been quite a bit of building activity this year; he has issued eight building permits so far this year.

Health Officer Report: The Health Officer was not present.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the election is June 11, so the Planning Board will be meeting on June 18. Trio SQL "play" is installed on all of the computers. Mary asked the Selectmen if she could use the Selectmen's discretionary fund to buy lunch for the election workers: The Selectmen agreed. She got an email from Senior Living Help, it assists Maine's Senior Citizens; she put a link on the Town's website. The bank balance is \$147,923.36

The Selectmen signed appointment for Mary Anderson as Assistant for General Assistance.

Questions and Comments:

Tom Johnston stated that the proposal for the DEP Bridge Grant has been submitted. Addie Halligan from Midcoast Conservancy was a tremendous help in the process and they have received confirmation of receipt. Tom spoke to Randy Butler from Dirigo Engineering, they will be responsible for permitting and he commented that we may need to review it; with the price of steel culverts going up, a bridge may be a more economical option.
