Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the bank balance is \$709,102.93; We received a Revenue Share check for \$11,373.88; We purchased a scanner for scanning voter cards and 2 storage bags for the sneeze guards (so they don't get scratched) with the grant money that we received from the state; The Town office will be closed Thursday and Friday for Thanksgiving.

Tom Johnston stated that we need to look into the new Paid Leave Act that goes into effect January first be sure that we are in compliance.

Other Agenda Items:

-The July and August bank statements were signed by the Selectmen.

-The Public Works Radio Frequency has been renewed and it is now active until 11/23/2030; The Fire Department frequency will have to be renewed in 2025.

-Tom Johnston asked about a radio for the new plow truck; He said that the Fire Department may have an extra one, he will look into it.

-Wesley Daniel asked Tom Johnston if he is going to speak to Brock Starbird about unfinished work and outstanding issues at the Town Garage and Tom said that he would.

-K&T has an offer for \$5,000 for the tanker chassis and there may be another party interested. They will most likely hear back from the other party next week.
