

Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

January 8, 2020

Tom Johnston called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of December 30, 2019: Motion to approve by Berkley Linscott, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Tom Johnston:

12/30/2019 6:30am-3:30pm: Fixed old tire chain for P-400; Fixed lights on P-500; Made up sand; Checked over trucks- P-400 had a blown hose, we replace it. I called the guys in at 11:30 to plow.

12/31/2019 12:00am-6:30pm: Plowed for snow and ice, Kevin, Greg, Jason and Frank.

1/1/2020 New Year's Day – Holiday, 5:00am-12:30pm: Called in guys to sand for black ice.

1/2/2020 6:30am-2:30pm: Kevin left at 2:00pm Greg and I left at 3:30 pm. We greased and fueled up loader and Skid tank; I called for salt; Fixed plow on P-400; Have a new chain coming for plow.

CEO Report: Bob Temple gave a copy of the draft letter from CMP for the power line on the other side of Route 17 to the Selectmen. He stated that he is working on the Finding of Fact for CTL Land Management regarding their new building; He will be on the Planning Board agenda for Tuesday. He is updating his forms for 2020. Tom Johnston asked what the progress is regarding the outstanding warrants. Bob Temple stated that they are all in the hands of Peter Drum, the Town's Attorney. Tom Johnston and Berkley Linscott asked about status of the property at the corner of Route 220 and Route 126. Bob stated that the owner does not have a permit and that he would look into it this week. Steve Ocean asked about a property on Route 126 that had burned down and he was wondering if it is a repair shop or junkyard. Bob replied that he would check it against the ordinance.

Health Officer Report: Brian Alves was not in attendance.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the tax relief checks from the state to homeowners that have the Homestead Exemption will be going out soon. They will be going out in batches alphabetically by town. The bank balance is \$803,009.55. She has begun sending articles to the printer for the Town Report.

Other Agenda Items:

Tom Johnston stated that they received a request from Ashley Elwell to join the Recreation Committee. Tom Johnston made a motion to accept to appoint Ashley Elwell to the Recreation Committee, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Question and Comments:

Steve Ocean stated that the Marijuana Ordinance Committee will be meeting a week from today. Peter Drum is writing the final draft and Steve expects to have it for the meeting to be approved. He stated that if the Selectmen want to have it available to be voted on at the Town Meeting a public meeting would need to be scheduled.
