



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

October 28, 2020

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of October 21, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

10/19/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm - Picked up p-300, Put cold patch in; Moved stuff around in shop so they could paint.

10/20/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Moved stuff in shop; Put chipper box on P-300 for chipping.

10/21/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Fixed tailgate on P-500; Patched shoulder on Vanner Road, which took 10 yards on reclaim; Chipped brush on Vanner Road.

10/22/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Put in salt; Chipped brush on Vanner Road; Moved stuff for painting.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that the State inspected the property on Prescott Road where they did all the timber cutting; they are suggesting that the Town request a replanting plan and financial penalty associated to it. Tom Johnston made a motion to have Bob contact the town attorney to develop a consent agreement, to include a replanting plan and the Selectmen will decide what the fine will be, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried; Bob stated that he wrote up a notice of violation for the property on Leigher Road. It looks like there is a camper and there are signs of wet areas where it looks like he is discharging liquid from the camper. Since there is a no trespassing sign up, Bob cannot enter the property; Bob received a call for another solar array in the Sukeforth pit; He created a list of the gravel pits owners who have not paid their fees. Tom Johnston made a motion to issue stop work orders for all gravel pits who have not paid their fees as of the end of October, they will be required to reapply for a permit to operate, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in favor, Motion's Carried.

Health Officer Report: No Heath Officer

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that we received a Revenue Share check for \$14,020.59; Joan held an Election Training today and it went very well; Don Grinnell has gotten us N95 masks from MMA for all of the Election Workers and two Union Ambulance workers came to show us how to fit them to our faces properly; The bank balance is \$868,257.70; We have had 450 Absentee Voters so far.

Other Agenda Items:

Sign down at the Village Park- Cassidy Parmley has volunteered to redo the sign down at the Village Park. The Town would have to pay for the materials and he would do the rest. He got a quote for a sign made with PVC. The Selectmen discussed it and Tom Johnston stated he would like to make sure that the sign retains the original shape. All of the Selectmen agreed. Mary will contact Cassidy about it.

The Selectmen signed the Engagement Letter for the Auditors.

Town Garage Update- Wesley Daniel called Brock Starbird to tell him that the paint and several other items were unsatisfactory; Tom Johnston mentioned that he had heard that Brock was using people that he was paying under the table- Brock told him that they were subcontractors and Tom asked to see proof of insurance. The Selectmen are going to meet with him at 10am on Friday to discuss matters.

-Tom Johnston stated that the Fitch Road bridge project is closed out. He is going to check to see when we will receive the Grant check.
