



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

July 1, 2020

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of June 24, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, with one correction: The CMP Pole Permit is on Leigher Rd. not Blair Rd., Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

6/22/2020: 6:00-4:30 We replaced a 15x40 and a 12x20 culvert on Youngs Hill Road and ditched.

6/23/2020: 6:30-4:30 We cut down trees and replaced 15x40 culvert and ditched.

6/24/2020: 6:30-4:30 We ditched on Youngs Hill Rd; Greg left at 3pm for a Dr. appt.

6/25/2020: 6:30-4:30 I looked at CMP pole on Leigher Rd, it is ok; We ditched Youngs Hill Rd; I saw Greg-Winter sand, he has about 1500 yards up

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he inspected the Town Pit; He and Wes went to Calderwood Road, where James Kearney had a concern regarding erosion, he believes that adding stone may be a good solution but he is going to reach out to DEP to get their suggestions if it is okay with the Selectmen, Wes and Tom said okay; He would like to get the junkyard inspections done in July.

Health Officer Report: Brian Alves said that all is well in town regarding Covid-19; Deb Vannah said that the food bank is going back to once a month; He is going to go over to Med-o-lark to check in regarding the campers.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that Kit posted the election notice and ballots around town; The town office will be closed for business on the day of the election, Mary and Stephanie will be busy in the Bryant room cleaning between voters and Joan will be in the office handling voter registrations; Sarah Masters suggested a meet the candidates zoom meeting for next Wednesday July 8th from 6:30-7:00pm; The town office will be closed Friday for the 4th of July; Mary suggested to the Selectmen that we raise the Notary fees, which are currently \$2.00. Tom asked to see a schedule of fees to review and Mary said that she will give it to him; the bank balance is \$138,993.56; Mary asked Charlotte Henderson to mention the wearing of masks for the Town Meeting.

Other Agenda Items:

-Frank Jones, Jr. okayed the location for the Pole Permit from last weeks' meeting.

-The Selectmen signed a quitclaim deed for a plot in Marris Cemetery.

-Charlotte Henderson presented a request for the Selectmen to sign a letter that she will use apply for a permit to remove the dam in the Village to help to reintroduced the Alewives to Washington Pond; When the dam is removed there will be a lot of silt that we need to be removed and disposed of, Tom suggested that it could be moved to the Town Pit; Tom Johnston made a motion to recommend removing the dam, Wesley Daniel 2nd, Berkley Linscott opposed, two in favor, one opposed, Motion passed.

Questions and Comments:

Wesley Daniel stated that he was not going to be here next Tuesday and someone else was going to have to do the Warrant.

Tom signed the contract with Dirigo Timberlands and the work is set to begin on Fitch Road on July 13th; he stated that there may be a possible phone/cable issue, he was waiting to find out.
