Tom Johnston called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of June 10, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Berkley Linscott, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Tom Johnston:

6/1/2020: 6:30-4:30 Marked Young's Hill Road for Digsafe #20202402540 and cut road for new culverts.

6/2/2020: 6:30-4:30 Took down big pine and a small one on Young's Hill Road; Chipped the brush.

6/3/2020: 6:30-4:30 I graded the Mountain and Lenfest Roads-6am-3pm (9 hrs); Kevin and Greg took gravel to roads; Took new culverts to Young's Hill Road 3pm-6:30pm I was in the pit checking winter sand and at Young's Hill Road with Digsafe.

6/4/2020: 6:30-4:30 Worked on P-100 lights and put hitch on; Fixed exhaust on P-200 and took back hoe ram to Union to be fixed.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he is working on the Solar array request; He is also working on the gravel pit inspections and would like to be done by mid-July; Building permits are up from years past; Tom Johnston asked when the Planning Board is going to resume meeting; It was discussed and Mary Anderson is going to review the Covid-19 guidelines and the meetings should resume in the near future.

Health Officer Report: Not present.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that they should decide by Wednesday, June 24 where to have the Town Meeting. The two options are Prescott Memorial on July 24th or the Fire Station on July 18th. Phil Muenier needs to be consulted regarding using the Fire Station; The new 2020 Town Warrant needs to be updated by the first week of July; The bank balance is \$124,360.19; We have borrowed \$250,000 from the line of credit.

Other Agenda Items:

There was discussion regarding the pros and cons of using the school vs. the Fire Station for the Town Meeting. The general consensus was that the Fire Station would be a better choice because the doors will open for air circulation and weather permitting, if necessary the parking lot can be utilized or if theirs is rain, the meeting room or the Bryant Room via Zoom; It would also be better for the Town's Fiscal Health to be able to commit the taxes a week earlier.
