Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of May 20, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

5/18/2020: 6:30-4:30 The Firs Rd is done, all ditched and crushed gravel 105 yards and screen gravel 175 yards; Marked Medolark Rd for ditching dig safe #20202103644.

5/19/2020: 6:30-4:30 We took out sanders and took off head gears on trucks and oil them.

5/20/2020: 6:30-4:30 We chipped brush on Medolark Rd.

5/21/2020: 6:30-4:30 We chipped brush and started to ditch on Medolark Road; Kevin is off the week of 5/25/20; I called FC Works on winter sand and they will call me back.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he passed out a violation for a driveway with no permit; He received an inquiry from Kenneth Mills who is interested in a new gravel pit; Berkley Linscott asked about the properties on Calderwood that seem to be in violation and Bob stated that he has attempted to speak to the owner but hasn't been able to; Tom Johnston and Berkley both inquired about the property on Rt. 17 and Bob stated that there are many outstanding issues that will have to be brought to court; He also stated that once the emergency has been lifted there is a backlog for the Planning Board that will need to be addressed.

No Health Officer Report.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that we received a Revenue Share check for \$13,514.00; We are going to attempt to have the Town Meeting on July 18th, the Saturday after the July 14th Election; Mary reached out to Mike Mayo regarding moderating the Town Meeting, she is waiting to hear back; Mary has been communicating with the insurance company regarding the damage to the Fire Department building and the fire truck; The town had to borrow \$100,000 from the line of credit to pay the school payment.
