



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of July 28, 2021: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

7/26/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- We ditched and cut brush on Prescott Road; Put up stop sign at 220 and 105.

7/27/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- We finished ditching on Prescott Rd; We cleaned out culverts on Youngs Hill Rd; I met with Wesley and an intern to discuss road way culverts.

7/28/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- We moved to Calderwood Rd and started ditching and widened out the shoulder; We seeded and put down jute mat.

7/29/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- We cut brush and ditched on Calderwood and seeded it; Pidacks is all done with winter sand and 1-gravel.

CEO Report: Corey Fortin stated that he issued a septic and building permit for a property on West Washington Rd.; He walked the solar project with a Forest Ranger and it was determined to be okay; The Jones pit was inspected; Corey stated that there has been no response from the residents on Route 17 that have the trash and septic issue. It was determined that if they missed the upcoming deadline, he was going to have to refer it to the town attorney.

Health Officer Report: None

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that we received a Veteran's reimbursement check for \$1,676.00; Bank balance is \$199,680.29; We received an MMA Worker's Comp reimbursement of \$511.00; Mary will be on vacation until next Thursday and will return on Friday, August 13.

Other Agenda Items:

Appointment to the Appeals Board: The Selectmen received a letter of interest from Kimberly Felicetti to be an Alternate Member of the Appeals Board. The Selectmen agreed to approve and signed the Appointment Papers.

Tax Abatement: The Selectmen received a request from Stanley Millay, Assessor's Agent, for abatement of real estate taxes for Map 19-Lot 22 because of an error in assessment. Wesley Daniel made a motion to approve the abatement, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

- Wesley Daniel stated that Frank Jones Jr. volunteered to mow the old dump site in exchange for the hay. The Selectmen agreed.

-Wesley Daniel stated that he was going to make an appointment to have the generator serviced. The Selectmen agreed.

-Letter from Dave Stanley from Tri-County Solid Waste Management: Dave Stanley wrote that he wanted to clarify that it is not free to dispose of town road trash at the transfer station.
