2/1/2021: 6:30am-4:30pm- Steven and Frank checked trucks; P-600 plow is cracking in the weld, Frank called HP Fairfield, they will call back.

2/2/2021: 12:00am-8:00pm-Called to plow, Frank called in Steven, Jason, Troy and Jimmy came in at 2AM to help.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the Workers' Comp Audit went well. Courtesy reminder letters for unpaid 2019 Real Estate Taxes went out last Friday. Last Thursday the Auditors were here for the day and they requested a few more items via email on Friday and they will meet with the Selectmen and Mary on Thursday. The bank balance is \$524,969.04. A snowmobile refund came in from the State for \$337.62 which will be sent to Matt Kopishke for the snowmobile club.

Other Agenda Items:

-The Union Selectboard will be meeting next Tuesday, February 16 at 6:30 via Zoom to discuss Union Ambulance. Tom is going to participate and hopefully we will have the Budget numbers by Friday.

-Wes stated that there has been a report from the Road Crew in regards to Lincoln Road that there is too much junk on the road to be able to plow and nowhere to turn around. Tom suggested that they stop plowing until the junk is cleaned up. Wes is going to reach out to the Millers.

-Jesse Casas stated that he is going to be resigning his position on the Planning Board when his term is up in 2021. The Planning Board is also short one Alternate member. The Planning Board is glad to see Corey Fortin in the Assistant CEO position. Jesse stated that Peter Drum, the town attorney, has not been timely in his response to matters that the Planning Board is waiting on to be able to approve two new Solar Projects in town. He has concerns that if the process takes too long, new businesses may avoid Washington and the Town may lose new businesses which would contribute to our tax base. Mary and Wes were going to reach out to Peter.
